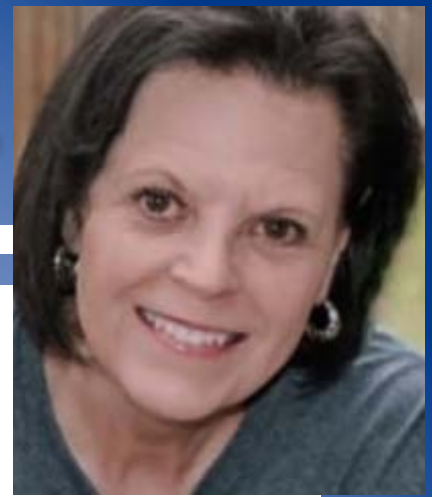

I hope by now your winter weather is all gone and you have your Foretravel Motorcade plans in place. These past few years have been tough on travel and I am looking forward to some really great adventures with the Motorcade Club this year. Many of these articles come from things that occur on our Motorcades as we travel the country. One thing that always seems to occur is air problems or more specific, a lack of air.

We all know we need the proper amount of air in our tires, air in our suspension system for travel and leveling, along with air in the slide out bladders for sealing purposes. But without the proper amount of air in our Brake System, we are not going anywhere!

Let me try to explain how that air gets there in the first place and some of the components involved. Our engine driven air compressor is a direct drive system so no belts to worry about. It gets its air from the engine intake manifold through the engine air filter and turbo charge system. That air pressure is regulated by the air governor which maintains pressure from 90 to 125 PSI and is adjustable.

As the air is compressed, it condenses and gains moisture. We don't want water in our brake systems as it would corrode the lines, valves, etc., and in freezing weather completely block air flow and our stopping ability! Hence, we have an Air Drier. Our Air Dryer takes all air from the compressor and runs it through a coalescing filter that traps any oils and particles that might come from the compressor. It

is then passed through the desiccant cartridge which removes moisture from the compressed air. The now dry air moves to the "Wet" tank where any remaining moisture should accumulate before moving on to both front and rear brake-tanks. This dry air is then used for braking and other accessories.

A purge valve on the dryer opens at the end of each compressor cycle when pressure set by the air governor, reaches its upper limit. The air and moisture is then expelled out of the dryer and desiccant cartridge back into the atmosphere. That's the noise we hear when the system "pops off" and we know we have air built up to travel on. This cycle continues over and over again as we drive and anytime the engine is running and the air governor is calling for more compressed air.

This is why it is essential to service our Air Dryers on a regular base. Foretravel has a dryer service kit that is available that has both the desiccant and coalescing filter cartridges, and they recommend servicing the dryer every 12 months. I also recommend replacing the high pressure relief valve that comes in these kits as they too can fail.

Over the years these dryers perform thousands of cycles. I have found that if not serviced properly, you will see excess water in your wet tank so drain it often. Also the desiccant will begin to break down and a white powder or (dust) will be seen when draining the tanks. This white powder can travel throughout the system, plugging brake and check valves along the way. Avoid this at all costs by having the Air Dryer serviced regularly.

As with everything, this dryer and its internal parts wear out with use and age. On almost every Motorcade, I have had at least one Air Dryer failure of some kind, usually on coaches 10 to 15 years old or older. The problem is that with all these cycles of drying air and purging of the system, something finally (usually from internal seals breaking down) gets stuck in the purge valve and you are no longer able to build air in your brake system. Now you're stuck where ever you are, unable to release the park brake, due to the lack of air.

The best way I know to keep this from happening on older coaches is to have the dryer assembly replaced or rebuilt whichever you prefer. Either way, a new or rebuilt Air Dryer will give you the peace of mind that you are good to go for many more years of worry free travel. I kind of look at it like tires. We know that tires age out no matter how good they look. Your Air Dryer is no different. It isn't a matter of "if" it's going to fail, but "when".

Of course, the best way I know to really travel "worry free" is to travel with us on a Motorcade. Not only do you not have to worry about where you're going, how to get there, or where you'll park at night, but also know if you can't "build air" in the morning, Donna and I will be there to see that you do!

Safety Reminders For DIY'ers

When parked, the only thing stopping your coach from rolling is the rear brakes. If you jack your rear tires up off the ground and your unit is on an incline, it WILL roll!

There are three "Height" valves under your coach. These commonly are referred to as "leveling valves". These valves don't care anything about "level". They want to attain a proper height i.e. a certain distance between the axle and frame. There is one valve at the front axle and it sets "ride

height" for the front of the coach. The other 2 are on either side of the drive (rear) axle and they set ride height for each side of the rear. If the coach leans to one side, it's likely a problem with one of the rear valves. All of these valves want to keep their respective positions at the proper height, so they will allow air to raise the coach if it's too low and expel air from the air bags to lower it if it's too high. The difference between aired up and down is about 3 to 3 ½ inches. Not a lot unless you are under

the coach or have placed something under it. That 3 inches can literally be a killer. If you jack up the coach higher than its ride height, the valve will deflate the air bags trying to get back down to the proper ride height. You then lower your jack and voila, the coach comes down 3 inches lower than when you started.

POLICIES RESERVATIONS

A \$500.00 deposit per event is required at the time of reservation. Full payment is due 90 days prior to the activity start date. A second deposit may be required and is due upon billing. Reservations may be made by mail or telephone by using your MasterCard, Visa, or Discover credit card. Failure to make required payments will result in losing your place in the sign-up rotation.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS

If reservations are canceled 90 days before the event, your deposits will be refunded less any unrecoverable monies retained by vendors from deposits made on member's behalf. If cancellation falls within 90 days prior to the beginning of the activity, 20% of the fees paid will be retained to cover the cost of postage, printing, supplies, bank charges, etc., plus any charges for any actual cost from guarantees and/or deposits made on member's behalf. No shows can result in no refunds. All refunds (except in very serious cases) will be charged 20% of the event fee plus actual cost from guarantees and/or deposits made on member's behalf.

Some special events have their own cancellation policies.

GUESTS

Arrangements and/or registration for all guests should be made upon registration or no later than 90 days prior to the start of any event.

STANDBY LIST

Space is limited on many events. All reservations are recorded in the order initial deposits are received. If received on the same day, they are handled in a lottery style manner. When a cancellation occurs, the first on the standby list is notified to fill the opening. Do not hesitate to sign up when discovering there is a standby list for an event. Very seldom have we had any standbys remaining at the start of an event.

SCOUTING AN EVENT

This occurs approximately one year prior to running the event. Pricing and finalizing with confirmation of all tours and attractions for each event take approximately four to six months after scouting is completed. Dates are tentative. Pricing and confirmed dates will be published in the Motorcader magazine.

THE FORETRAVEL WAY

With Chapter rallies and motorcades coming up, that normally includes some delicious pot luck nights. Here are a few recipes to try when the main dish or meat is being furnished. Both of these are quick, easy, and oh so delicious. Be ready, they are going to asking for your recipe!!

Roasted Garlic Potatoes

INGREDIENTS

- 3 pounds baby red potatoes, washed and quartered
- 1/4 C (60ml) olive oil
- 6 large cloves of garlic, finely chopped or minced
- Salt and black pepper fresh cracked
- 1 tablespoon Italian seasoning
- 3/4 C Parmesan cheese, fresh grated
- 1/2 C unsalted butter
- Fresh chopped parsley, garnish
- 1/2 C crispy bacon bits (optional)



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Preheat your oven to 400°F (200°C). Grease a large baking sheet with non-stick spray or olive oil and set aside.
2. Parboil baby red potatoes in boiling water for 5 to 8 minutes to precook them. The potatoes will be more tender on the inside when roasting.
3. In a large bowl, combine 1/4 cup of olive oil, garlic, salt, herbs, pepper, and parmesan cheese together, mixing to combine. Add a little more olive oil if the parmesan cheese has absorbed most of it.
4. Toss parboiled potatoes through the garlic parmesan mixture to evenly coat.
5. Arrange the coated potatoes cut side down in a single layer onto the prepared baking sheet. Place the baking sheet on the bottom rack of the oven. Bake your garlic butter parmesan potatoes for 25 minutes, turning after 15 minutes with tongs or a spatula, until potatoes are browned and crisped at the edges.
6. In the meantime, gently melt butter in the microwave and combine with fresh chopped parsley. Remove the roasted potatoes from the oven, and drizzle with the butter parsley sauce. Add bacon bits, toss to coat well, and serve your roasted potatoes with garlic butter parmesan immediately. Enjoy!

Bacon & Parmesan Roasted Asparagus

INGREDIENTS

- 12 strips of bacon
- 2 bundles of asparagus
- 1 Tbsp Parmesan
- 1/2 a lemon
- sea salt & pepper to taste



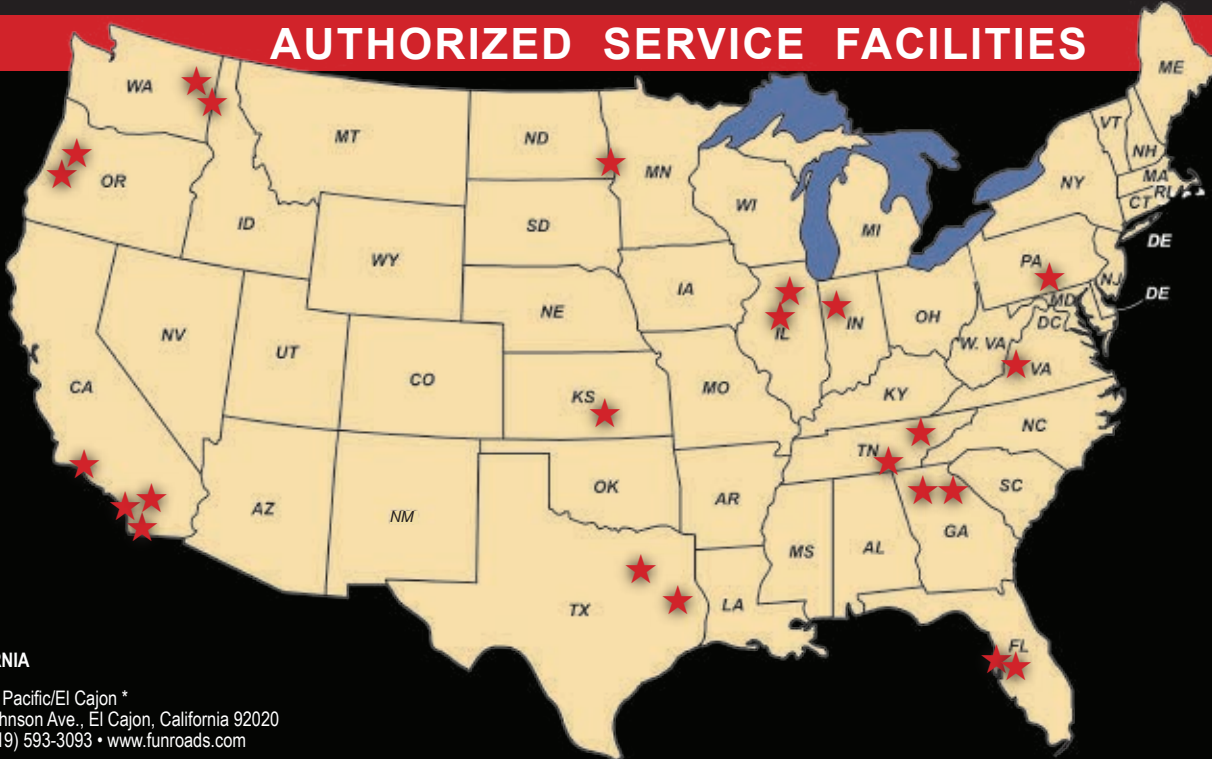
INSTRUCTIONS

1. Preheat oven to 400 F Line strips of bacon on the baking sheet. Use parchment paper if you're using a metal baking sheet; skip the parchment if you're using stoneware (recommended).
2. Cook bacon for 15-20 minutes, or until desired crispness. Transfer bacon to paper towel and drain all but 1 Tbsp of bacon grease from the pan.
3. Trim asparagus ends. Spread spears onto the baking sheet, rolling them around to coat in reserved bacon fat. Sprinkle with Parmesan cheese and crumble on cooked bacon. Cook for 18-20 minutes, or until tender.
4. Squeeze on juice of half a lemon before serving.

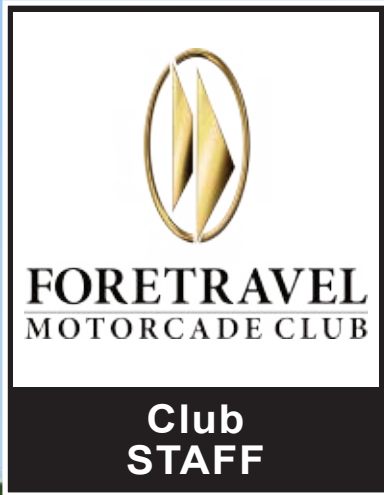

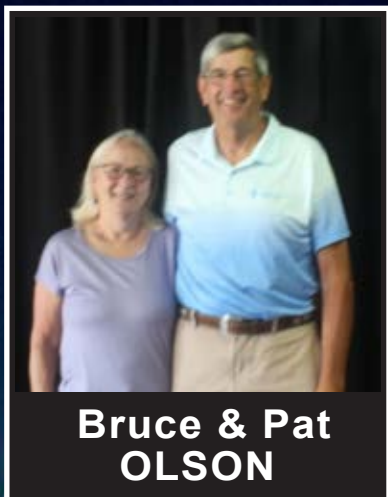

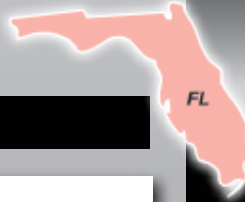
